TIN: Tax Payers Identification Number; EIN: Employer Identification Number; FEID: Federal Employer Identification Institution Code: A College Board Designated Institution Code allows colleges, universities, and other higher education organizations to receive SAT and AP score reports.

OPIED Number: The Federal School Code List contains the unique identifiers assigned by the U.S. Department of Education to schools participating in the Title IV federal student aid programs.

DUNS: The Data Universal Numbering System, abbreviated as DUNS or D-U-N-S, is a proprietary system developed and managed by Dun & Bradstreet that assigns a unique numeric identifier, referred to as a "DUNS number" to a single business entity. It was introduced in 1963 to support D&B's credit reporting practice
